- Fulfilling compliance with all applicable environmental obligations (legal and other requirements).
- Full co-operation and maintenance of open relationships with relevant interested parties.

As contractors we:

- Wherever possible and appropriate, we will be proactive in using carbon friendly alternatives, discuss with our clients and supply the benefits of solutions that reduce our footprint, use construction methods, equipment and techniques that reduce the impact on the environment compared to traditional methods whilst fulfilling our legal and contractual obligations.
- Plan to minimise the waste of materials, resources and energy, promote recycling, reusing and dispose responsibly of any waste products arising from our activities.
- Understand the impact of our Scope 3 emissions and therefore procure materials from sustainable sources where possible.
